Discipline = To teach

- ✓ Teach children to self-regulate- promote focus, attention, positive interactions (breaths, “I message,” *flashlight of attention*)
- ✓ Teach ways to manage emotions, promote effort
- ✓ “Be your best self.” “You must be proud of yourself.”
- ✓ Contact the teacher first if there is an issue in the classroom.
- ✓ Contact the principal if more support is needed and/or issue is outside of classroom.
- ✓ Work as a team

What Parents Can Do

Establish a **consistent bedtime routine**.

Have your child **unpack his/her backpack**.

Involve your child in making **decisions about lunch and snack**.

Lay out clothes for the next day.

Let your child participate in **simple household chores**.

Teach self-help skills.

THINK ALOUD as you process and engage in tasks.

Final Thoughts:

- Ensure your child arrives to school on time.
- Keep dismissal plan consistent. Send yellow note the morning of any change.
- Keep your emergency contacts up to date. Include anyone who may pick your child up from the bus.
- Get involved with our school and GPFA. Attend meetings!
