STUDENTS: WHICH COLLEGE ADMISSION PROCESS BEST SUITS YOU?

Non-Restrictive Application Plans

Regular Decision

DEFINITION:

Students submit an application by a specified date and receive a decision in a clearly stated period of time.

COMMITMENT:

NON-BINDING

Rolling Admission

DEFINITION:

Institutions review applications as they are submitted and render admission decisions throughout the admission cycle.

COMMITMENT:

NON-BINDING

Early Action (EA)

DEFINITION:

Students apply early and receive a decision well in advance of the institution's regular response date.

COMMITMENT:

NON-BINDING

Restrictive Application Plans

Early Decision (ED)

DEFINITION:

Students make a commitment to a first-choice institution where, if admitted they definitely will enroll. The application deadline and decision deadline occur early.

COMMITMENT:

BINDING

Restrictive Early Action (REA)

DEFINITION:

Students apply to an institution of preference and receive a decision early. They may be restricted from applying ED or EA or REA to other institutions. If offered enrollment, they have until May 1 to confirm.

COMMITMENT:

NON-BINDING

Students are not restricted from applying to other institutions and have until May 1 to consider their options and confirm enrollment.

Students are responsible for determining and following restrictions.

Rights and Privacy Act. Since FERPA is a complex law, we want to provide some key information before you respond. We encourage you to learn about FERPA by [reading our FAQ](#). We also suggest discussing FERPA with your counselor, parent, guardian, or other school official to be better informed about your rights.

- How does FERPA relate to your college application?**
 - FERPA regulates the privacy of student education records, which could include your application to the college where you enroll. FERPA also gives you the right to review confidential letters of recommendation provided as part of that application after you enroll.
- In a moment, you'll be asked if you want to waive the right to review confidential letters of recommendation. What should you know about this waiver?**
 - Waiving your right lets colleges know that you do not intend to read your recommendations, which helps reassure colleges that the letters are candid and truthful.
 - Some recommenders may decline to write a letter for you if you do not waive your rights. Check with your counselor or teachers to see if any of them follow such a policy.
- Still unsure how to respond?**
 - That's OK. Many students are. Before you move on, take a moment to discuss your decision with your counselor, another school official, or your parent/legal guardian. For more information about FERPA, visit the [Help Center](#).

College Visit Policy for Seniors

Many college admission representatives come to Cold Spring Harbor High School each fall and spring to meet with students. The visitor schedule is posted on the bulletin board just outside the Counseling Center window, and the visits are listed both in Naviance and in the morning announcements. College visits last for one period; students are responsible for noting the time so they are not late to their next class.

Seniors may attend during lunch or free periods and may also **request** that teachers excuse them from classes. Your schedule will be checked when you arrive to sit in with the college representative and you will not be admitted without a College Visit Pass signed by your teacher. Please be courteous and request that your teacher sign the pass no later than the day before the visit. **You are responsible for all material covered in missed classes and you may not miss a scheduled examination to visit with a college admission representative.**

Interested students should register to attend sessions by visiting their Naviance accounts at <https://student.naviance.com/cshhs>. Enter your user name (your email address) and the password you chose when you registered for Naviance to access your account. Call or visit the Counseling Center if you have trouble with your account.

To see the visit schedule and register:

1. Access your Naviance account
2. Click on the "colleges" tab
3. Under the "colleges" tab, click "Research Colleges"
4. Click on "College Visits"
5. Search or scroll down to view upcoming colleges that are visiting CSH. Click "Register Now" if the date and time works for you – to miss a class complete the College Visit Pass below, print the entire page and present it to your teacher
6. Then click on the name of the college and you will be taken to their website – you can do a little research and be better prepared to converse with the representative
7. You will receive an email reminder on the day before the visit.

Student Responsibilities in the College Application Process

Documents students are responsible for sending to colleges:

1. College applications and application fees – (Common App and college-specific online apps)
2. Application supplements required by colleges
3. SAT and/or ACT scores (AP scores are optional; you can self-report them)
4. Financial Aid forms
5. NCAA Clearinghouse registration and fee, transcript, SAT/ACT scores, amateurism confirmation

“Forms” students complete

1. Transcript Release Authorization with all signatures
2. Requests for counselor and teacher recommendations to be sent (Naviance)
3. Common App or specific college Early Decision agreements
4. Arts or Athletic Common App supplements

Final note – Students:

1. Maintain complete responsibility for the college application process
2. Check the Naviance account to determine that counselor and teacher documents have been downloaded by colleges
3. Acknowledge teachers who have written letters on your behalf (written on nice stationery)
4. Must withdraw all other applications filed if accepted under Early Decision
5. Must maintain your grades
6. Send your first quarter grades to colleges that want them (or send them if you believe doing so will enhance your application, especially if you are working with a particular admissions counselor). A fax with a brief cover sheet or a scan accompanied by an email will suffice.
7. Notify your counselor of the outcomes of each application (accept, wait list, deferral, deny). Let your counselor know, too, if you have withdrawn any applications.
