Regents exams and review classes may still be taken at St. Anthony's with permission of the CSH Principal/Guidance Counselor.

SUMMER SCHOOL GRADING POLICIES:

If a student retakes a course over the summer, both courses will remain on the transcript, but only the higher grade will be factored into the GPA. If students repeat a course that was an Honors or AP during the year, there is no option for Honors or AP over the summer so the summer course will not carry the same weighting (1.1) as the course that was taken during the year. If a student retakes a Regents exam and receives a higher grade, that exam grade will appear on the transcript. This higher grade however will NOT lead to any change in the final grade received in the course in June.

In all cases, students and parents must consult with their guidance counselor and secure the appropriate permission to take courses and Regents exams. Counselors have materials for each of the available summer school programs.
