#### **Principal's Corner**

This week at West Side, second graders participated in a mystery powders lab and continued to draft their "all-about" books. Our third graders worked on iPads as part of our eSpark pilot project. Students worked in small groups, each with their own iPad, to become more familiar with the system. Third graders also studied the Amber Brown series. Mentor texts play a critical role in teaching students how to read and write effectively. Students in fourth grade continued to support their theses in writing as they drafted persuasive essays using graphic organizers and referenced anchor charts for support. Our fifth graders began their exploration of the Westward Movement and used a variety of nonfiction texts during their research. They also explored new ways to identify and add fractions with unlike denominators, and participated in another lab with a scientist from the DNA Learning Center. Sixth graders participated in a boat building contest, using pennies for passengers, that supported their labs on density. They also began to work with coordinate planes in math as they solved equations. This week, we said good-bye to the large traveling map of North America. Thankfully, I was able to participate in one more game of Simon Says with some of our third graders. Finally, our students in fourth, fifth, and sixth grade attended a concert in the gym led by the Heritage Blues Trio. Thank you to Ms. Daniels and the music staff for collaborating with the artists at Lincoln Center to make this happen. The concert ended with a number that had all students and teachers in the gym dancing. What a success!


Your child will receive a T-shirt, Embroidered shorts and a headgear. Awards will also be handed out on the last day of practice.
