It's that time of year again! The **Lloyd Harbor Theatre Arts Club** will present *Disney's Aladdin* on March 25 and 26, 2015

Sixth graders interested in participating in the production should attend a review of the script and audition songs on Tuesday, December 9, from 3:15-5:30. Dance auditions will be held on December 9^{th} as well, so attendance at this meeting is very important!

<u>Please see the attached list of songs to learn PRIOR to the first meeting on</u> December 9th

Vocal auditions will be held on Thursday, December 11, 3:15-5:30

Acting auditions will be on Tuesday, December 16, 3:15-5:30

Final Auditions/ First Full Cast Rehearsal will be on Thursday, December 18, 3:15-5:30

Please bring a recent picture of yourself to the vocal audition. DO NOT submit the picture to your teacher OR bring it to the main office. Bring it with you to auditions. Include your name and your teacher's name on the back of your picture so it can be returned to you when casting is complete.

Accepting a main part in the play requires 3-4 days per week rehearsal commitment. If you already have a busy after-school activity schedule, I recommend you join a singing and dancing ensemble, as you will typically have only two rehearsals per week.

A Commitment Contract, presented at auditions will state:

- Three absences allowed. If you are absent, it is your responsibility to check with a fellow cast member <u>before</u> the next rehearsal to find out what you missed. If you are a lead, ask your counterpart to stand in for you.
- No absences will be allowed March 9-March 26

Three stage crew members will be selected from each 6th grade, based upon teacher recommendation, considering the student's level of cooperation, reliability and a desire to learn backstage mechanics of theatre. Stage crew commitment runs from March 16-March 26

Please understand, if your child is selected for a major speaking part, he/she is expected to meet the time commitment involved.

Finally, the participation fee of \$50.00, payable to "LHSPTG Lloyd Harbor Theatre Arts Club," helps to defray costs of the production and must be paid following the posting of the cast. Please send the participation fee and your signed permission slip to the main office in an envelope addressed to: "LHSPTG Lloyd Harbor Theatre Arts Club." Include your child's name and teacher. You will also need to give your teacher your transportation slip for each day you attend.

We look forward to bringing Disney's Aladdin to life on our Lloyd Harbor stage.
