Directions to West Side Run

The West Side School is located just one block north of Route 25A in the village of Laurel Hollow, Syosset, NY.

From the West

Take the LIE or Northem State to Route 106. Tum left- North, to Route 25A, Northem Blvd. Tum right- East, on 25A. Continue for 3.2 miles, just past the 4th traffic light, tum left onto Laurel Hollow Road (don't go down the hill on 25A). Follow the signs to the parking area.

From the East

On 25A continue through Huntington and Cold Spring Harbor past the Fish Hatchery, on left, and the Cold Spring Lab, on right, up to the top of the hill on 25A. Tum right on Laurel Hollow Road at the hilltop, *before* the traffic light. Follow the signs to the parking area.
