Lloyd Harbor School is a community of readers and writers. We anticipate that our students will regularly read books that are a good personal fit, continue to enjoy favorite authors, and find new authors and books to inspire and entertain throughout the summer months.

This year, the Summer Reading Program will be centered on *choice*.

- All students are asked to read *at least* one book from the enclosed book list that will be used as a sharing opportunity when they return to school in the fall.
- Once students have read their selected book(s), they will complete the enclosed "Book Review Notes" sheet (additional forms will be available on the LHS website under School Notices). These sheets must be given to the classroom teacher no later than **Friday**, **September 15** and will be used for a celebration of reading.
- In September, students will work with their classroom teachers to enter these reviews on our electronic library system (Destiny). This will allow students to access book recommendations created by their LHS peers!

We are looking forward to sharing these summer reading contributions, which will allow us to stay connected and bring us together as a school community in September.
