As a recognized 2013 Blue Ribbon School, we were asked to submit a proposal which was accepted last summer. After preparing throughout the fall, we presented on "Fostering a Growth Mindset and Grit in the Elementary School." During the presentation, we shared what has been accomplished in our school community over the past eighteen months. The workshop highlighted the importance of recognizing failure as an attempt to be successful, acknowledging students for showing perseverance, and creating a culture that understands the positive impact this can have on our students and their learning.
