Fashion Design

Supplies needed:

- A combination lock
- Drawing pencils and eraser
- 3-ring binder for hand-outs
- pocket folder with holes punched and placed in the binder for sketches
- white tee shirts, at least 2 (to be brought in when assigned)
- ready made clothing that may be used as a base for a garment (to be brought in when assigned) **These clothes will be greatly altered so old or unwanted clothing will be appropriate.
- any materials that the designer chooses to use that is not in our own school supplies **There will always be enough materials available to students in school, so as not to incur unnecessary expenses.

Expectations and Grading:

- An assignment will be presented on the first school day of each month and is due on the last school day of each month.
- Rubrics defining the points/credit for each aspect of the assignment will be given to the students during the assignment's introduction.
- The rubrics will address the creative art process, coming to class on time, work ethic, clean-up, due dates and class participation.
- The points earned in each rubric will result in a grade for each month's assignment and average out to quarterly and final grades.
- Designers will be assigned an art bin that will contain a glue gun, scissors, brushes and other art materials necessary to a particular assignment. These items are school property and the student is responsible for returning them, in good condition, at the end of the school year or pay for their loss/replacement.
- The art bin is to be secured by a combination lock brought in by the students to safeguard the contents. It may go home or stay in school.
- Designers are expected to be part of our Annual Fashion Show which is scheduled for Friday, May 14th, 2010 at 7:30pm in the PAC.
- Designers are responsible for finding their own models for the show.
