All students are to follow the instructions listed below. Each student will receive an index card with a room assignment and then enter the PAC. Students will be escorted to their rooms from the PAC by the proctors.

Please note: The College Board prohibits the use of cell phones during any standardized test, and students will be dismissed from the exam even if the cell phone rings. Unfortunately, students have been dismissed before because they instinctively answer if the phone rings or vibrates despite having been instructed to turn off the phones upon arrival.

Please do not call your student to inquire about dismissal time; the approximate times appear below. It is difficult to predict the exact dismissal times with such a large group of examinees.

If you <u>must</u> call, please call the number listed below. Doors are locked during the test for security reasons and to prevent interruptions. If there is an <u>emergency</u> you must enter the building via the Loading Dock entrance and ask the custodian or one of the hall monitors to find Mrs. Cambria.

- Any calculator that requires an electrical outlet
- Any calculator that makes noise or "talks"
- Any calculator with characters 1 inch or more high, or with a raised display
