Classroom Rules:

1. Arrive to class on time. If circumstances cause a student to be detained, entrance is *quiet*. Late note should be placed on teacher's desk before student takes his/her seat.
2. Homework will be checked and reviewed at the **BEGINNING** of the period. An *incomplete* assignment, as well as a *list of answers* is a **0!** *All work must be shown No Exceptions!*
3. Textbooks are to be covered at all times but may be left at home.
4. Absence is **NOT** an excuse for reporting to class without homework. Student is responsible for obtaining the assignment missed due to absence and return to class with the notes and the assignment completed. If absence exceeds one day, additional time will be allowed to get work done.

Grade Policy: *Student's numerical marking period average is out of total points earned.*

1. TESTS/QUIZZES (let's call them "*QUESTS*")

Tests are announced with adequate warning. If a student is absent for a test, the *student* is responsible to make an appointment for a *make-up test*. If the student fails to schedule this appointment or forgets to show up for the make-up test, the test grade will be averaged as a zero. If a student signs in or out of school legally the day of an exam, it is the student's responsibility to take the exam on a *free period* **THAT DAY!** If a student fails to do so, he/she will receive a zero for the exam.

Quizzes may be announced or unannounced.

Take Home Tests are assigned with **MORE** than enough time to finish them. Take Home Tests count as a regular 20 point quiz grade in your average. For every day it is late, 5 points will be deducted from the average. They will not be accepted after 3 days.

A final Exam will be given in June and will cover only the topics learned after the regents exam.

2. QUARTERLY EXAMS

Students will be taking the **MATH B REGENTS EXAM** in **January** this year, and therefore they will be given one quarterly exam and the end of the first quarter. Intense review will begin at the start of the second quarter.

3. HOMEWORK/CLASSWORK

100 Points will be allocated towards homework/classwork at the beginning of each quarter.

Homework is assigned **EVERY** night and check regularly!! (This includes study time as well as written homework). Homework that is assigned from the textbook **MUST** be checked by the student in the back of his/her book each night. Each written assignment must be neat and **COMPLETE** with the assignment listed on top of the page. A maximum of 5 points may be deducted from the 100 points for each incomplete assignment. If a student is unprepared for class (i.e.: notebook, calculator, paper, pen or ruler) a maximum of 5 points will also be deducted from the student's overall points earned. Classwork consists of being respectful to both teacher and classmates (no talking during the period), being responsible for your actions, being prepared for class and giving 100% effort to every lesson. A maximum of 5 points will be deducted for inappropriate behavior.

4. MATH TEST DAY

A math test can be given on "Math Test Day" which is _____ Wednesday _____, or on a Monday, which is open test day. Quizzes can be given on any day of the week.

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5. SUPPLIES

Students must have a binder with loose leaf, graph paper and two folders with them everyday. Additionally, students must have a graphing calculator, pens, pencils, and a straight edge everyday.

6. ATTENDANCE

The attendance/late policy for this school is strictly enforced. Excessive lateness and absences **WILL** result in loss of campus privileges. The signing in late of school **DOES NOT** entitle any student to additional time to prepare for a test or quiz.
