GENERAL CLASSROOM RULES AND REGULATIONS

(I) PRINCIPLES:

- 1) Be respectful and polite to others
- 2) Be responsible for oneself
- 3) Be prepared and give 100% every day
- 4) Attend class, on time, every day

(II) QUARTER GRADE CONSISTS OF:

- 1) Quizzes given during a chapter (Each vary in point value)
 - 2) "Chapter Tests" given at end of each chapter (Each: 100 points)
 - 3) "Homework/Participation" grade (Each quarter starts at: 100 points)

(III) CLASSROOM RULES AND CONSEQUENCES:

1) Be prepared every day. This includes having: pen, notebook, previous days' lecture notes and hand-outs, textbook, graphing calculator, homework, etc. In order to get the most out of each lesson, all of these items must be with you, at your desk, every day.

Consequence: Loss of points on your "homework/participation" grade.

2) Be on time every day. This means being at your desk when the bell rings to begin class. A "pink pass" from the main office allows you in the classroom, but you are still considered "late to class."

Consequence: Loss of points on your "homework/participation" grade.

3) Make every effort to attend class every day. This means your "seat-time" in the classroom is very important. Not being in class for whatever reason, such as signing in late, signing out early, any absence at all, hinders the learning process.

(a) If absent from class on the day of a lecture...

Consequence: you are responsible for all work missed; this includes getting lecture notes, homework, and any miscellaneous information from a fellow classmate, as well as seeing me before the next lecture (preferably in the morning) for any hand-outs you may have missed.

(b) If absent from class on the day of a "quiz"...

Consequence: same as above, but now you are also responsible for coming in the very next morning (7:15 a.m.) and seeing me to take that quiz, before it is returned to the other students. If this is not possible, then the test you'll be taking at the end of the chapter must also then be counted for this missed quiz. Please be sure to see me.

(c) If absent from class on the day of a "chapter test"...

Consequence: you must take a "chapter make-up test", which will be given at the end of the quarter. Please be sure to see me before the last week of the quarter to make arrangements.
