Students will participate in various individual and group activities that service and support our school and community.

A key component of each class will be participation. Participation will be evaluated in a variety of assessment tools. GRADING

- Attendance (20%) In order to participate, students must be present and on time for class. Consistent lateness to class with or without a pass will result in a deduction of 2 points per late after 3 lates to class. Cutting class will result in a deduction of a half a grade, no exceptions.
- ➤ <u>Projects</u>- (40%) A student's ability to work with a team and to lead will be evaluated. Projects will be focus on school and community service. An interview and research assignment will be required for a value of 100 points per marking period.
- ➤ Cooperation/Behavior/Participation (40%) Your ability to work with others is key to a successful class. Interrupting, calling-out or any other behavior that shows lack of self-discipline or respect for others will jeopardize one's grade.
