Required materials needed for class:

- 1. A notebook that will allow you to take notes during class.
 - This may be in the form of a spiral notebook or a loose-leaf notebook. Please be advised that throughout the year I will ask you to turn in class assignments and you will need paper. If you do not like to rip pages out of a spiral then you may want a loose-leaf binder.
- 2. A folder with pockets so that you can keep all of the handouts with you.
- 3. One package of 3 by 5 index cards to have available to you at all times.
- 4. A writing utensil each and every day.

Office Hours:

Any time that I have a free period you are welcome to come for extra help. In the event that we cannot coordinate a similar time during the day I will be more than happy to stay after school as long as you let me know ahead of time that you want to see me.

The Break Down of the points for the course:

1. Homework: 5 points for each assignment

2. Quizzes: 50 points

3. Tests: 100 points

a. Each semester we will have a project assignment to complete that will count as 100 points. This is a great opportunity for you to boost your test grades as these projects are generally creative in nature and they are usually a reinforcement of the material covered so far.

Attendance:
