SUMMER ASSIGNMENT 2015

This two-part summer assignment from Mrs. Oswald is going to be fun...

- #1- Please take at least <u>20 still photos</u> throughout your travels this summer.
- #2-Gain access to a video camera (yes, an iPhone, or any other phone would work-provided that you hold it horizontally. NO VERTICAL SHOOTING, please!) The video snippets I would like you to film are of actions. There's no wrong answer to this. I will need you to have (30-40) 10-second clips of actions that you were a part of throughout the summer. You do not have to be in the footage, it just has to be footage of something happening in a 10-second interval. Honestly, the more you film, the better. For example, if you are going out on a boat, you could film someone walking by, and getting on the boat. You could have that person walk by a second time, and focus only on their feet. Another clip can be shot while you are on the boat. Please alter your camera angle when shooting. Shoot some clips from above, some at eye level, and some below. The idea is that the person you are filming can (but does not have to) look at the camera while you are filming.
