- V. This course studies grammar, vocabulary, and literature. Our grammar study focuses on common writing errors and mistakes in usage. Vocabulary comes from the vocabulary workbook and selections we read. We will read fiction, nonfiction, and poetry in preparation for the English Regents Exam. Writing is a key factor in this class as we prepare for proficiency exams and college admissions.
- VI. The grammar for this class comes from SAT review material and examples found in student writing. The vocabulary workbook is level F. Fictional works include The Catcher in the Rye, The Great Gatsby, Ethan Frome, The Old Man and the Sea, The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn, The Monkeys, The Crucible, and Death of a Salesman.
- VII. Grading Policy: Tests, Essays, and Projects are worth 100 points each; point values for Quizzes will vary; Homework is calculated as a percentage completed of the total assigned and converted to a 100 point test grade; 10% of the quarter grade is based on Participation, including the Start Journal.
