We will select our works from the following-

Short fiction and poetry from *The Bedford Reader* and other sources *An American Tragedy* by Theodore Dreiser *The Awakening* by Kate Chopin *Crime and Punishment* by Fyodor Dostoevsky *Cry, the Beloved Country* by Alan Paton *Fences* by August Wilson *Hamlet* by William Shakespeare *King Lear* by William Shakespeare *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest* by Ken Kesey *Othello* by William Shakespeare *The Scarlet Letter* by Nathaniel Hawthorne *The Turn of the Screw* by Henry James One full length work of the students' choice

The students will be doing projects each quarter for the outside reading choice. Quarter one's project is a book review.

GRADES: Grades will be based on participation in class discussion, reading quizzes and tests, essays and projects. MOST essays will be scored on the A.P. Literature Essay Grading Scale (attached). Students are afforded the opportunity to rewrite any essay until one week before the quarter ends. To do this, the student must see me and go over the draft and plan the rewrite. Any essay receiving a grade under 70 must be rewritten. Class participation will make up 10% of the quarter's score. Included in this is attendance, participation in discussion, and note taking. Both lateness and absence will result in a loss of points. In quarter four, the final research paper will count at least 50% of the quarter average.
