## Procedures for running for office

- 1. Each candidate must complete the candidate application form to become eligible to run for Student Council. The Election application can be found on the Jr. High page of the school website, in the Jr. High Office, and with Mr. Schiffmacher.
- 2. When petitions are returned to Mr. Schiffmacher, students will be officially registered as candidates for office.
- 3. All applications are due to Mr. Schiffmacher by Wednesday, September 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 4. All applicants <u>MUST</u> attend a meeting on Wednesday, September 25<sup>th</sup> <u>after</u> <u>school</u> to discuss the responsibilities of candidates and officers.
- 5. Campaign posters may ONLY be hung on the walls of the Junior High Wing and Cafeteria B. Mr. Schiffmacher or Mr. Monastero must approve and sign all posters before they can be hung up.
- 6. The election assembly speeches for grade 7 and 8 will be held during each of the lunch periods on Wednesday, October 2, 2013 for 8<sup>th</sup> grade and Thursday, October 3, 2013 for 7<sup>th</sup> grade. The election speech of each candidate must be approved by Mr. Schiffmacher before it can be delivered.
- 7. The election of officers will be held during homeroom, Friday, October 4<sup>th</sup>.
