Procedures for running for office

- 1. Each candidate must obtain ten (10) signatures of support to become eligible to run for Student Council. The Election Petition (application) can be found on the Jr. High page of the school website, in the Jr. High Office, and with Mr. Schiffmacher.
- 2. When petitions are returned to Mr. Schiffmacher, students will be officially registered as a candidate for office.
- 3. All applications are due to Mr. Schiffmacher by Wednesday, September 22nd.
- 4. Campaign posters and/or stickers may ONLY be hung on the walls of the Junior High Wing and Cafeteria B. Mr. Schiffmacher or Mr. Monastero must approve and sign all posters before they can be hung up.
- 5. The election assembly speeches for grade 7 and 8 will be held during each of the lunch periods on September 27th. The election speech of each candidate must be approved by Mr. Schiffmacher before it can be delivered.
- 6. The election of officers will be held during homeroom, Tuesday, September 28th.
