- ✓ Please carpool, as parking will be limited.
- ✓ Water will be provided for the children throughout the day.
- ✓ Watermelon will be served during the event, courtesy of the GPFA.
- ✓ A fruit juice ice will also be served at the end of the event.

Please send a note to your child's teacher if you do not want your child to have the watermelon or fruit juice ice.
