If you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to call me.

Finally, please remind your child that s/he will not be able to play handheld video games during outdoor recess. We want the children engaged in physical activity during their recess periods! Also, if your child brings a cell phone to school, please remind him/her that it must be kept in the backpack throughout the school day.

There is nothing more wonderful than the sounds of children playing happily at recess! Thank you for your continued support as we work together to ensure that every child has fun and feels safe and comfortable at West Side School.
