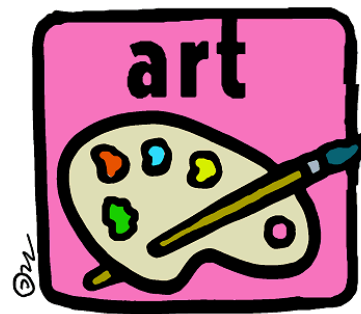

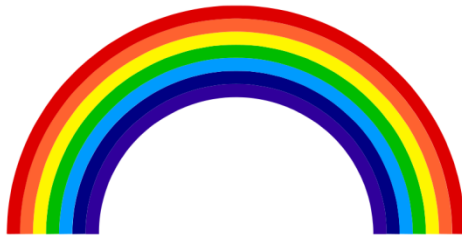

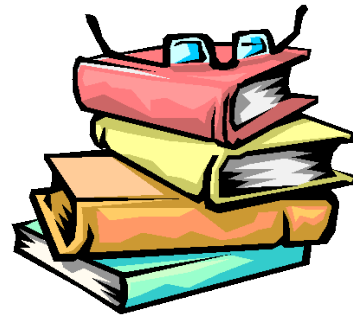

Materials You Will Need:

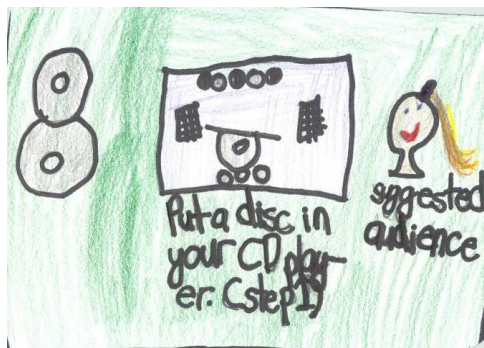
1. CD player

That is how to take care of a toad! Make sure you take it outside every once in a while and let it hop around.

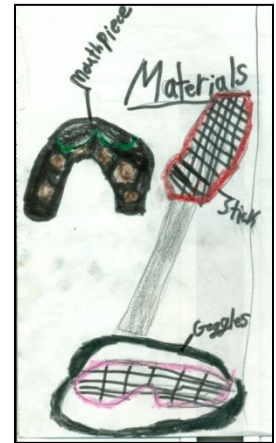
How To Gear Up For Lacrosse

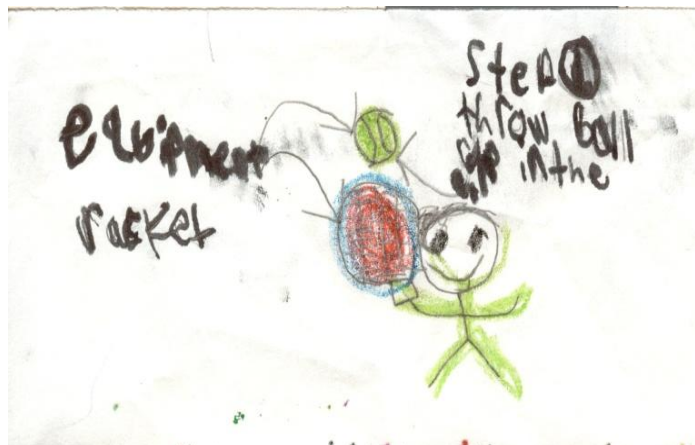
How To Hit a Tennis Ball

How To Do a Camel Catch Spin

MATERIALS:

12. Then, lift up that foot a little and put it on the ice quickly. Lift up your left foot high and bend your skating knee.
13. Put your left hand in front. **THAT IS YOUR LANDING!**
