

If you're not a writer, you will never know the excitement of thinking about what kind of story to write next.



5. Last, when you've butterflyed nearly all the thread, pinch the butterfly where the threads criss-cross and lift it off your finger. Wind the last bit of thread around the center of the butterfly to keep it together.



No such thing as a state test.





Loveable Animals





On her way to school, Caroline was skipping. In the middle of skipping, Alex said, “Hey Caroline, pick up that flower.”



"This is how we will get even Alex," said Caroline.


"OK. I guess I will give it a try," said Alex.

“But I don’t feel well,” Josie said.


“Are you trying to make up an excuse?” her father asked.

“I told you. I knew you would have a great time Josie,” her dad said.


“Dad, I want to come back again and again!” Josie replied.


The Big Surprise

"Yes, Mrs. Parting?" Liam replied.


"Why are you cheating?" Mrs. Parting asked.







“Sure,” I replied to Moe’s question.




“Where are you?” whispered the witch and no one answered, so he quickly robbed the frog. The frog got so mad!



Earth Day




The Amazing Earth
