### Goals for the 2013-2014 School Year

THEME: Fostering social and emotional strengths and building climate

GOAL 1: 3rd Grade Recess Buddy Program - Pilot twice weekly for one month

- Empower our younger learners to take on a leadership role
- Help the socialization process
- Training and Orientation Process:
  - o Brainstorm possible games to play during indoor and outdoor recess times
  - $\circ$  At least two second graders and three to four 4<sup>th</sup> graders in a group
  - Students must exit recess together and report to an aide on duty
- Selection process:
  - Work with 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade teachers, aides, school psychologist, and principal
- Reflection:
  - o Newsroom will be used for students to reflect on experience
  - Possible Questions for Grades 2 and 3:
    - Would you recommend this program to another 2<sup>nd</sup> grader? Why or why not?
    - Is recess different now in any way? If so, explain.
    - What did you get out of this experience?
    - How did you help?
- A certificate will be provided for each student involved in the program.

### **GOAL 2**: Building on the First Grade Orientation Foundation

- Mentors in 5<sup>th</sup> grade work with 1<sup>st</sup> graders when they visit WSS in the spring
- Give tour of building and introduction in the cafeteria
- Students could also support other building tours
- ✓ Match 6<sup>th</sup> graders with 2<sup>nd</sup> graders the following fall
- Could pair them up throughout the year with their buddies
- Celebration the following fall similar to summer reading celebration
- Some similarities to Summer Reading Celebration
- New maps added to orientation folders for student support
