Student Behavior

Students are **expected** to behave properly during after school activities, like they would during regular school hours. Students are to keep their hands, feet, and objects to themselves and refrain from using foul language.

If a student does not behave in a proper manner, the instructor will follow the below procedures.

1. Instructor will give a warning to the student and discuss ways to correct his/her behavior.
2. Instructor will contact the child's guardian and make them aware of the situation.
3. After speaking with the child's guardian, if the child's behavior does not improve, the student will **NOT** be permitted to attend classes and a refund **WILL NOT** be given.

Children may not attend after school activities unless they have been registered for the eight week term. This includes children attending play dates.
