The HS Musical Theater and 5th through 8th grade choral students are being offered the experience of performing with this professional musical group. The evening concert is open to all families in our school district and promises to be an unforgettable experience.

Broadway in South Africa was founded by a Broadway actor from "RENT" named Adam Kantor. As a student, Mr. Kantor sang in an ensemble at Northwestern University, which was invited by the South African Consulate to visit townships outside of Johannesburg and Capetown where they conducted workshops for children. Since that time, Mr. Kantor has organized a volunteer group of actors who return to South Africa annually to bring the joy of music, theater and dance to kids in underprivileged communities who are desperate for hope and inspiration. In the form of a cultural exchange, South African children write essays, poems and stories, which are set to beautiful music by professional composers here in the United States. The money that BSA raises goes to help needy students in South Africa.

## Preparation & Requirements for Fifth and Sixth Grade Participation:

- Participation in this event is voluntary. Students who choose to perform must demonstrate mature and responsible behavior, follow directions carefully, and exhibit a positive attitude towards singing.
- Mrs. Visceglie will teach and review the selections in music class. Students should memorize the lyrics.
- Students will be asked to attend extra rehearsals.

## Rehearsal & Concert Schedule:

- On **Thursday**, **November 3rd**, 5th and 6th graders who elect to participate will be transported by bus to CSHHS at approximately 12:50 PM. At that time, we will have a rehearsal, combining four grade levels from three different schools. Elementary school children will arrive back at their home schools by 3 PM in time for dismissal.
- On Friday, November 4th, students meet at the PAC promptly at 5:45 PM over an hour before the concert begins. Parents must provide transportation for their children to and from the PAC. The show will conclude before 8:30 PM.

Therefore, it is imperative that students return the permission slips to Ms. Visceglie ASAP and no later than Wednesday, October 19th.
