The Town of Oyster Bay along with our co-sponsors, the Long Island Flag Football League and the N.F.L., will once again offer non-contact NFL Flag for boys & girls ages 6-17 years old. Last year's program was a huge success with over 1500 participants learning & enjoying Flag Football in a safe, NO CONTACT format. As we have in the past, all "friends" will be placed on the same team to assist parents coordinating rides. All games last one(1) hour and are played on Sunday afternoons sometime between 12-4 pm, at fields closest to where you live. Your child will be placed on a team from the same school. You may also register a full team of neighbors/classmates. NYS certified H.S. football officials are used and alternate play-dates are available for any Sunday game that conflict w/religious holidays. There is NO blocking in flag football so it doesn't require week-night practices that infringe upon a student's homework/study time. There are six regular season games followed by play-offs and a Super Bowl. The season kicks-off Sunday, September 16th. This program is not affiliated with any school districts.
