SIXTH GRADE INTERIMS ON E-SCHOOL

Sixth grade progress reports have now been posted on the e-school parent's portal. They can be activiated the same way you activiate report cards. If you need assistance, please follow the instructions that are available to you on the district website.

PROPER CLOTHING

As the weather gets warmer, it is important for students to continue to dress suitably for school. Please take a moment to review our guidelines on appropriate clothing (as stated in the Student Agenda Book): Students may not wear short-shorts or flip flops (rubber beach shoes). Sneakers are the preferred choice of footwear. We appreciate the continued support from parents and students.

SELECT CHORUS

Rehearsals are from 3-3:45 on Friday May, 23rd and 30th. Pick up at the back circle.

4TH GRADE BAND

In order to prepare the 4th grade band students for their concert on June 11th, there will be required early morning rehearsals starting at 8AM in the Band Room on the following days: May 21, 23 and 30th, June 4, 6th and 11th. In order to participate in the concert, students are required to attend these rehearsals. Students should bring their instruments and the Essential Elements 200 Book to the rehearsals.

DRIVING CAUTION

When driving on the school grounds, be mindful of our traffic patterns and be sure to proceed with caution.

ABSENCES

Your child's absence is being recorded as an unknown and unexcused absence if you do not make a phone call to the nurse's office. Although an absence note is still required, it is not sufficient. The phone call must be made.

AFTERNOON PICK-UP

For safety reasons, we ask that all children being picked up in the back circle wait in line until picked up. Children are not allowed to cross over the parking lot.

EARLY PICK-UP

If you decide, after your child has left for school, that you need to pick him/her up early, it is not necessary to call ahead. Please just come to the front office and we will call your child for dismissal. Back-up notes are still necessary when your child has a change in transportation at the end of the day.

MORNING ACTIVITIES DROP-OFFS

Only those children who have a scheduled morning activity may be dropped off before the 8:30AM start of school. We do not have the personnel to monitor students left here before this time.

AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES - DISMISSAL

All students attending an after-school activity will be picked up at the back circle. Please follow the traffic pattern of the PM dismissal (reverse traffic flow). As always, the safety of our children is paramount. Children are not permitted to cross between cars or through the parking lots.

Please note there will be no access into the school after 4:15pm unless it has been previously arranged.
