Dear Sixth Grade Parents and Students:

As you are aware, our trip **Matilda** has been scheduled for next **Wednesday, November 20th**. We are looking forward to a wonderful day. Below you will again find details of this event and helpful information.

TRIP SPECIFICS

- ALL school rules are in effect and **electronic devices, such as video games, ipods, cell phones and cameras, may not be used during the trip (as well as on the bus)**. If any such device is seen, it will be taken away by the chaperone.
- **The buses will leave Lloyd Harbor at 8:15 am. PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE!**
- Students will report to the café for attendance and wait to be escorted to the buses. Please sit at your assigned lunch tables.
- You may not bring your own snacks for the bus. Only school-provided food may be eaten during "snack time".
- **Students must pack their own lunch. No glass bottles please.**
- Students may bring a small backpack to carry their lunch.
- It is not **necessary** for the children to bring any money with them for shopping or food, as our time in the theater is limited.

PICK UP

- **We hope to return to school at approximately 6:15 pm.** If the time deviates more than a half hour (either way), a "connect ed" message (automated call) will be sent to your primary phone number.
- Parents should pick up their children by the Little Theater entrance. Please park your car and walk to the door to meet your child.

Students should remember that this is a Broadway performance **and dress accordingly**. Shorts are not permitted and sports jerseys and athletic attire are strongly discouraged. Also, the students have been reminded that our best LHS behavior is expected at all times.
