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### A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL **SPOTLIGHT ON... LHS ROAD TRIP!**

Among our winter field trips, our students are traveling to California! Well... they're not actually going there, but they are working together to accumulate miles to move them across the country. Under the direction of physical education teachers Mr. Lynch and Mr. Toscano, students in grades 2, 3 and 4 are participating in the Lloyd Harbor Road Trip Challenge! Children are given a piece of paper with three sneakers on it. Each time they do 20 minutes of physical activity outside of school, they write the activity on a sneaker and color it in. When the whole page is filled (60 minutes of activity), it is turned in to the teachers. Each sheet that is submitted equals three miles on the map and the class that does the most miles is considered the 'winner'! For this round, it took a month and two days to reach California. Class 3 Terry won our first trip with 538 total miles completed. In March, they will start another round of the contest with the return trip home. Thank you families for supporting our teaching and learning in physical education! Being active is important to the body, just the same as our academic work.

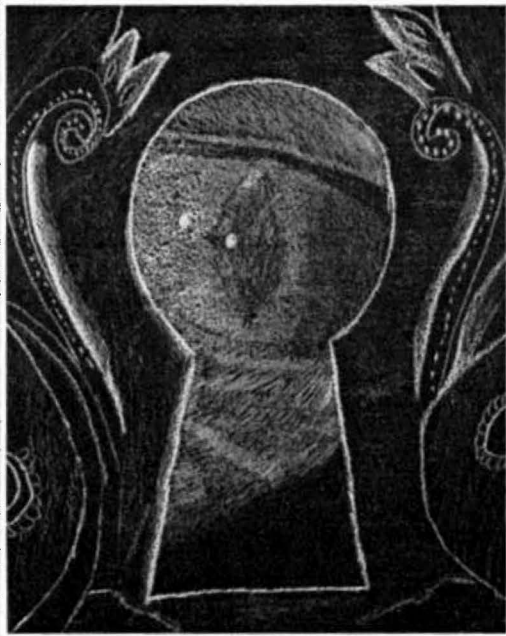

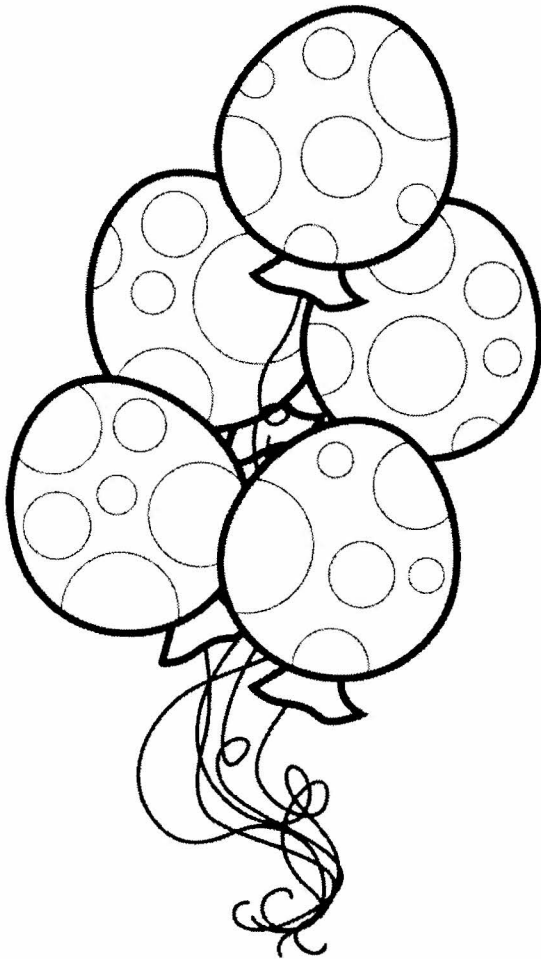
