FIELD TESTS

Each year, NYS "Field Tests" are administered to students in different grades to provide feedback for the construction of future test questions. These types of exams in no way affect a child's record and scores are not sent to us. This year, our school has been assigned to administer the <u>Grade 6 ELA – Writing Field Test</u>, which will take place on June 5th. The exam will last approximately 40 minutes. Please note that if your child refused the NYS ELA Exam, they will not participate in this testing session. If you have additional questions, call the main office.

EARLY PICK-UPS


