MAIN OFFICE COMMUNICATION

Just a reminder, email is not an effective way of contacting us when situations arise that need immediate attention. A phone call to the main office will allow for a prompt response which, as you know, is very important to us. We also need to remind you that changes in dismissal must be decided on the night before and sent directly to the classroom teacher through a note with your child (not an e-mail). If an emergency arises and you have to make a change in your plans during the day, please call the main office. At that point, we will ask you to follow-up in writing. This, however, should be the exception, not the rule. Additionally, when scheduling "play dates", please know that students may not bring more than two friends home on a bus (due to space and safety).
