## COLD SPRING HARBOR SCHOOLS BOND REFERENDUM



#### **BOND REFERENDUM JANUARY 18, 2017**

The Board of Education has approved a resolution to present to the district voters a proposed bond to construct a 9,798 sq. foot Physical Education Center at the Jr./Sr. High School.

- The proposal will be a \$4.8 million bond to be funded over 20 years. The annual budgetary impact would be approximately \$98 for the average tax payer.
- This facility will be used primarily for the Jr./Sr. High School physical education program for all students in grades 7 through 12.
- More detailed information is available on the district website (www.csh.k12.ny.us)
- A Bond Brochure will be mailed to the community before the scheduled vote in January with further details.

(Voting will take place in the high school field house from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. on January 18, 2017. Residents may vote in person or by absentee ballots)




