Cool The Earth

This week, our LHS students joined over 100 schools nationwide inspiring kids and their families to reduce their carbon footprint at home! At an assembly on Wednesday, the High School Environmental Club presented a fun, inspiring play which explained the concept of climate change to the kids. After the assembly, the kids went home with coupon books which encourage them to take carbon-reducing actions like take shorter showers, pack a no-waste lunch, and bike, walk or carpool to school. Many of our students and their parents already pledged to take energy-saving actions as outlined on the coupons and returned the coupons to school where they are tracked on a banner. Through the actions pledged in the *Cool the Earth* program, the **Lloyd Harbor** school community will save an estimated 600,000 pounds of carbon from being emitted into the atmosphere. The program will run for the next several weeks and culminate with our Earth Day Celebrations in April. Coupons will be collected every Friday during lunch periods. Dear Parents,

We are pleased to announce that the Nominating Committee of the Lloyd Harbor School Parent Teacher Group (LHS*PTG) has been formed. The committee has begun to address its important responsibilities and the LHS*PTG would like to thank them for their dedication.

On behalf of the Nominating Committee, we would like to invite any parent who will have a child in Lloyd Harbor School during the 2012-2013 academic year to submit his/her name if he/she wishes to be considered for a position on the LHS*PTG Board. This is also an opportunity to nominate someone you know who would like to be on the Board. Each position on the board is listed and briefly described below.

1. President: Works collaboratively with the LHS*PTG Board to establish and maintain the goals and objectives of the LHS*PTG throughout the year. Presides at all LHS*PTG meetings and LHS*PTG Board meetings. Acts as a liaison to the Principal. Attends or appoints a representative to attend various district-wide meetings, including Board of Education, District Committee on Shared Decision Making, CPC and SIT meetings.
2. Vice President: Oversee pulling together all information for the school directory as well as coordinate printing and dissemination to PTG members. Perform duties assigned to him/her by the President.
3. Committee Coordinators: Selects committee chairpersons with input from the Board. Coordinates the sign-up forms for parents interested in serving on a committee and oversees the work of these committees. Participates in all committees on an as-needed basis and presides over the organization and transfer of materials from outgoing committee chairpersons to their successors.
4. Secretary: Responsible for recording, distributing and posting the minutes of the organization's meetings. Conducts the official correspondence of the organization and acts as LHS*PTG's historian. Initiates the Nominating Committee process.

5. Treasurer: Responsible for receiving all monies of the organization and keeping accurate records of receipts and expenditures. Provides regular financial statements at LHS*PTG meetings and maintains records that will be audited annually. Prepares an annual budget with the assistance of the LHS*PTG Board.
6. Communication Coordinator: Coordinates the communications of the LHS*PTG, which involves assisting with the Friday Notes. Acts as Web master: responsible for coordinating, and regularly inputting data on, the school web page. Oversees the database containing LHS*PTG members' contact information.
7. PR Coordinator: Responsible for the gathering of the LHS Community information and disseminating it via a newsletter. Responsible for welcoming new families.
8. Fundraising Coordinator: Work closely with Treasurer and fundraising committee chairpersons to ensure the overall effectiveness of PTG fundraising efforts as well as the goal of enriching the children's education. Make suggestions to the Board for improvements, additions, and removal of specific fundraising programs.

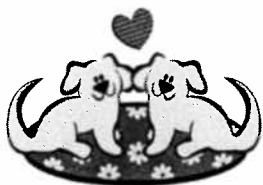

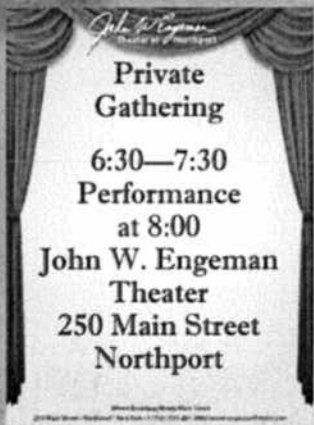
