Please remember this is a Broadway performance and dress accordingly; sports jerseys, athletic attire (including shorts) are strongly discouraged. DUE TO LIMITED TIME WITHIN THE THEATER, PLEASE DO NOT SEND CHILDREN WITH ANY MONEY FOR SHOPPING OR FOOD. Lastly, school rules are in effect and electronic devices, including cell phones, may not be used during the trip (as well as on the bus). Students who are not attending Spiderman will remain at school and follow a special schedule.

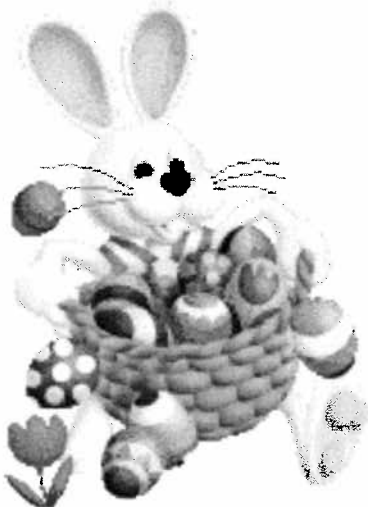
