### **Cafeteria/Lunch Enhancement Project**

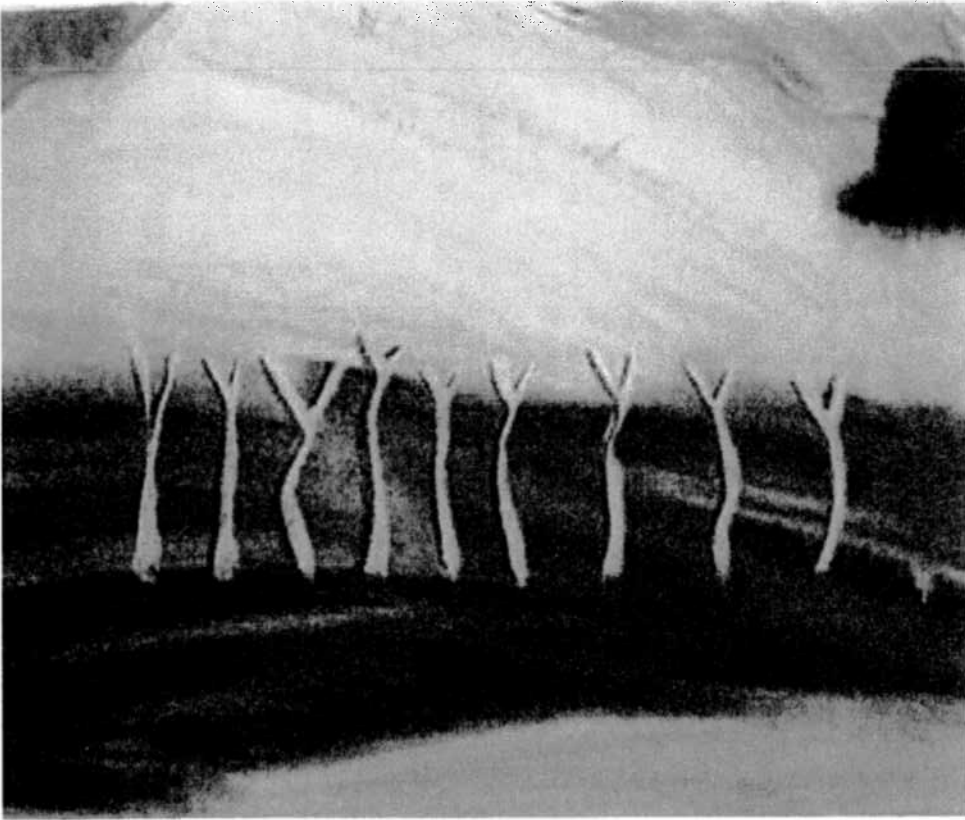
