FROM THE NURSE

Sometime before the end of the school year, please stop by the Health Office during school hours to pick up your child's remaining medication. If you do not, the medications will be discarded. Your child is not permitted to bring the medication home.

All **third graders** are required to submit a recent health appraisal and dental certificate prior to entering fourth grade. All **fifth graders** are required to have the Tdap booster prior to entering sixth grade. All required paperwork must be brought to the health office. Students who are medically excused from physical activity are not permitted to participate in physical education and recess until a doctor's clearance is submitted. If a child is absent from school due to illness, he/she is not permitted to attend any after-school activity.
