### Photo Day

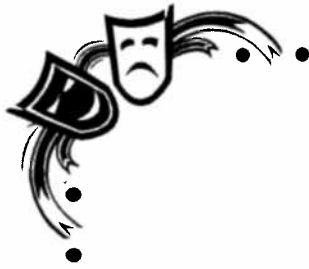

Dear Parents and Students:

The Lloyd Harbor Theatre Arts Club will present *My Favorite Things*, an adaptation of Rogers and Hammerstein's *The Sound of Music*, on March 29 and 30, 2012.

**Fifth graders** interested in participating in the production should attend a review of the script and audition songs on **Tuesday, December 6, 3:15 - 4:30**. **Sixth graders** may attend on **Wednesday, December 7, 3:15-4:30**. If you cannot attend, but wish to participate, you may pick up a script at the main office on those days.

**Acting and dance auditions will be held on Monday, December 12, 3:15 - 4:30 for the fifth grade and Thursday, December 15, 3:15-4:30 for sixth grade in the Little Theater.** If you have a conflict with religion, you may attend either audition.

**Vocal tryouts will be on December 13, 3:15 - 4:30 for fifth grade and December 14 for sixth grade, 3:15 - 4:30 in the Little Theater.** Again, please plan to attend on the day you don't have a conflict. *If call-backs are necessary, they will be held on Friday, December 16, 3:15 - 4:00 in the Little Theater.* The cast will be announced on Monday, December 19.

Accepting a main part in the play requires four days per week rehearsal commitment. If you already have a busy after-school activity schedule, I recommend you consider trying out for the nuns of the Abbey or a minor speaking part, as you will have no more than two rehearsals per week.

Two stage crew members will be selected from each fifth and sixth grade, based upon teacher recommendation, considering the student's level of cooperation, reliability and a desire to learn backstage mechanics of theatre. Stage crew commitment runs from March 16 to April 2.

Finally, the participation fee of \$35.00, payable to "LHSPTG Lloyd Harbor Theatre Arts Club," helps to defray costs of the production and must be paid following the posting

of the cast. Please send the participation fee and your signed permission slip to the main office in an envelope addressed to: "LHSPTG Lloyd Harbor Theatre Arts Club." Include your child's name and teacher. **You will also need to give your teacher your transportation slip for each day you attend.**

Please understand, if your child is selected for a major speaking part, he/she is expected to meet the time commitment involved.
