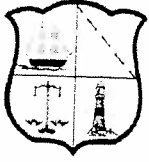

- *encouraging children to try their hardest*


• ***making sure children arrive to school on time!***

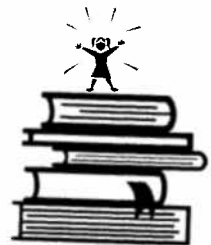
EXAMS BEGIN PROMPTLY AT 9:00 am.
