CrossFit Limitless

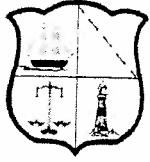


Parents can help to prepare their children for success by:

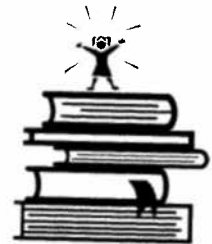
- *ensuring children get a good night's sleep before each day of testing*

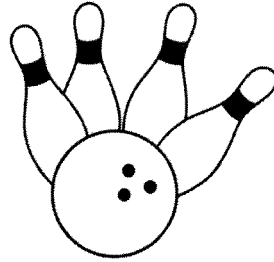
