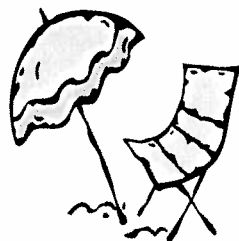

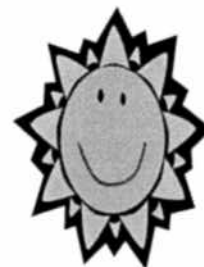

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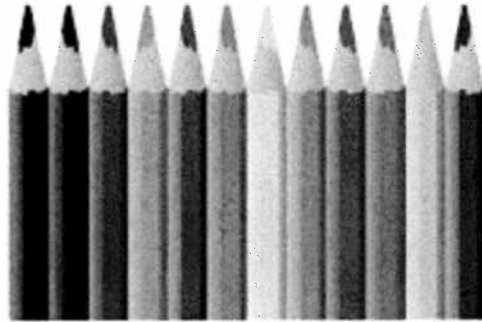

He competed in both the 1992 Summer Olympics, where he competed for the Unified Team, and the 1996 Summer Olympics, taking third and fourth respectively. He is currently an assistant coach at Nassau Community College. He is the NJCAA Wrestling Coach of the Year 2012.

Vougar's son, Nick Arujau, is a three-time state champion from New York (2008, 2009, 2010) and All-American. Nick is currently on the Cornell University wrestling team.

Mike Graffolla- Four Time High School State Champion from Virginia, High School National Champion and NJCAA National Champion.
