Retake Day: Tuesday, November 13, 2012

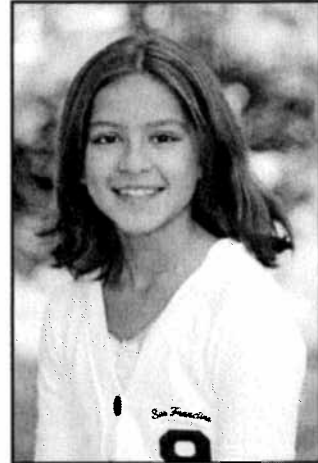

Free interactive on-line tutoring through **Brainfuse!**

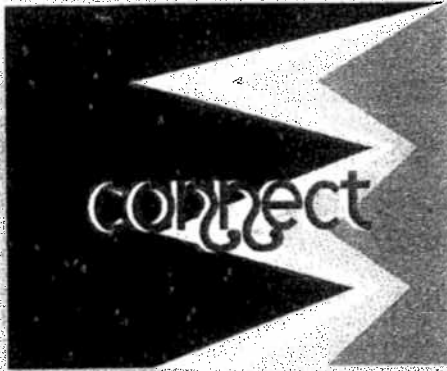

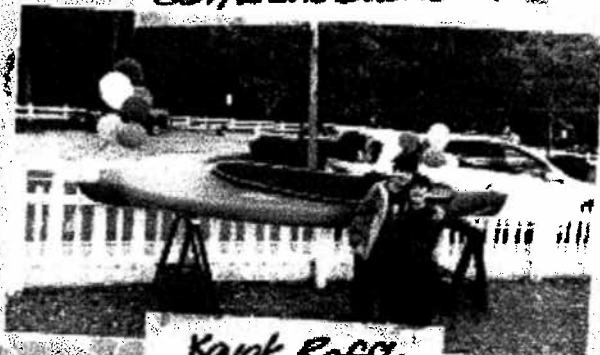
