Save the date! The Book Fair will take place October 10-12. More information will come soon.

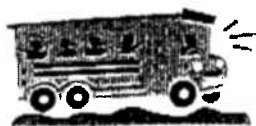

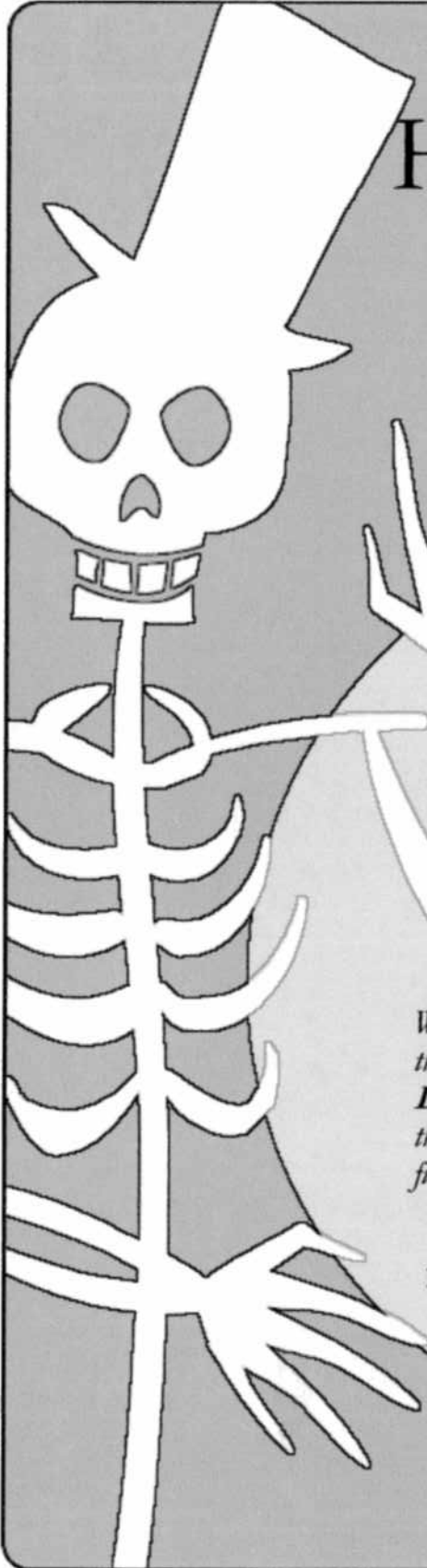

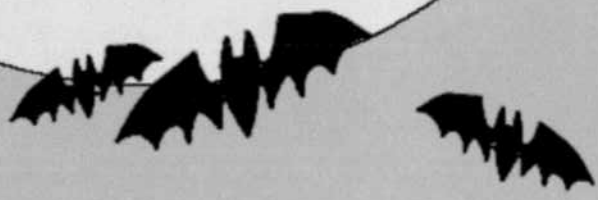
