Chrome extensions are great. Extensions are small software programs that customize the browsing experience. They enable users to tailor Chrome functionality and behavior to individual needs or preferences. Each extension you have running adds function while eating up a little bit of ram slowing down your computer. Most users have extensions running that they are not using.

You can stop an extension the same way you can end a Chrome tab. But it's also a good idea to go through your Chrome extensions and disable or remove those you don't use by heading to the Chrome settings > More Tools > Extensions. Here you can remove and turn on/off all of your extensions. There are also extensions that you can install that allow for quick access and control of extensions. I use "Extensity."
