Auditions will take place Tuesday, January 9 and Thursday, January 11. Attached, you will find the three choices for vocal auditions. Each song can be found on YouTube.com. The link is provided <u>below</u> the song title. The start and end times of the audition cuts are listed <u>below</u> the song title as well.

Vocal Auditions will take place on **Tuesday**, **January 9**th **from 3:15-5:30**. **Acting Auditions** will take place on **Thursday**, **January 11**th **from 3:15-5:30**. Students will be provided with acting audition material at <u>vocal auditions</u>.

On Friday, January 12th, students will receive an invitation to join the cast, which will list the role(s) that they received. Attached to the invitation will be a commitment contract that must be signed by parents and students and returned by January 19th. The first rehearsal will take place on January 19th from 3:15-5:30.

As a reminder, the **performances** will be **April 26-27**. **Rehearsals** will be on **Tuesdays**, **Thursdays and Fridays from 3:15-5:30**. (Not all students will be called to every rehearsal. Schedules will be posted weekly). For **the two weeks prior to the show**, **rehearsals will be every day** (Monday-Friday). Finally, there will be a **Dress Rehearsal on Saturday**, **April 21**. Please mark your calendars accordingly.

We understand that this is a large time commitment, but your efforts will be well worth it when you experience that magic that will take place on the Lloyd Harbor stage. Break a leg and remember the most important part of the audition process: <u>have fun!</u>
