Identifying a Prepositional Phrase as an <u>Adverb Phrase</u> or an <u>Adjective Phrase</u>



FIRST, ALWAYS identify the <u>PREPOSITIONAL PHRASE</u> by (boxing it out.)

Ask yourself...."What is this phrase telling me more about?"

If it is telling you more about a.....

NOUN or PRONOUN Then it is an **ADJECTIVE PHRASE**.

If the PHRASE is answering one of these questions.....

What type?

or

Then it is an ADJECTIVE PHRASE

Which one?

If it is telling you more about one of these.....

VERB, ADJECTIVE, ADVERBThen it is an **ADVERB PHRASE**.

If the PHRASE is answering one of these questions.....

Where?
How?
Then it is an ADVERB PHRASE.
When?
