Section 1: Aggression Leads to War

Soviet Union

- Stalin creates a <u>TOTALITARIAN</u> government
- A single party controlled every aspect of the peoples' lives.

<u>Italy</u>

- Mussolini starts a <u>FASCIST</u> government
- A political system based on militarism, extreme nationalism, and blind loyalty.

<u>Germany</u>

- Hitler creates a <u>TOTALITARIAN</u> government
- Nazi Party uses <u>racism, nationalism and fear to</u> <u>rule the people</u>.

<u>Japan</u>

- Military leaders controlled the government
- Needed to expand to <u>find more space and more resources</u>.







Appeasement

Great Britain and France <u>qave into Hitler's demands</u> for more territory....they <u>hoped to AVOID WAR.</u>



United States

<u>Neutrality Acts</u> \rightarrow <u>did not allow the U.S. to get involved</u> in another war in Europe.

War Begins......

Hitler invades Poland and France.....

Great Britain is left to fight Germany <u>ALONE</u>......

<u>Battle of Britain</u>..... Germany continuously bombs Britain.



Section 2: The United States at War

Lend-Lease Act: <u>The U.S. lends war supplies to Britain.</u>

Now, the U.S. is involved in the war.

Atlantic charter: FDR and Churchill meet secretly to discuss the world and the war.





<u>December 7, 1941</u>

Pearl Harbor is attacked by the Japanese

<u>The United States declares war</u> <u>on Japan</u>



Bataan Death March

- > Japanese soldiers capture Allied soldiers in Philippines.
- Prisoners are <u>forced to march 65 miles</u>.
- Many are killed and many die from sickness.

<u>"Rosie the Riveter"</u> = symbol of women's efforts during the war.








Japanese Internment


- U.S. government orders <u>Japanese-Americans to be moved to camps to</u> prevent sabotage and spying.
- Some of their *rights are suspended*.







Nuremberg Trials

<u>Nazi officials</u> are charged with <u>war crimes</u>, <u>found quilty</u>, and <u>executed</u>.
