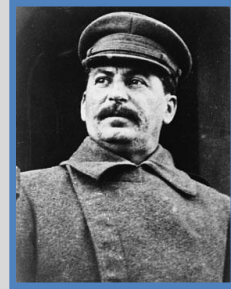

Section 1: Aggression Leads to War

Soviet Union

- Stalin creates a TOTALITARIAN government
- A single party controlled every aspect of the peoples' lives.



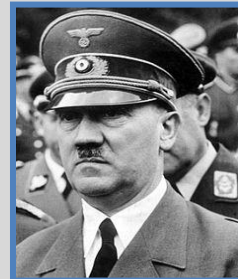
Italy

- Mussolini starts a FASCIST government
- A political system based on militarism, extreme nationalism, and blind loyalty.



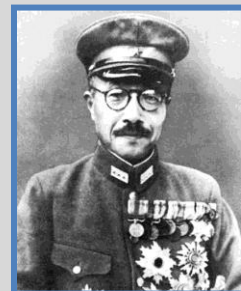
Germany

- Hitler creates a TOTALITARIAN government
- Nazi Party uses racism, nationalism and fear to rule the people.



Japan

- Military leaders controlled the government
- Needed to expand to find more space and more resources.



Appeasement

*Great Britain and France gave into Hitler's demands for more territory....
.....they hoped to AVOID WAR.*



United States

Neutrality Acts → did not allow the U.S. to get involved in another war in Europe.

War Begins.....

Hitler invades Poland and France.....

Great Britain is left to fight Germany ALONE.....

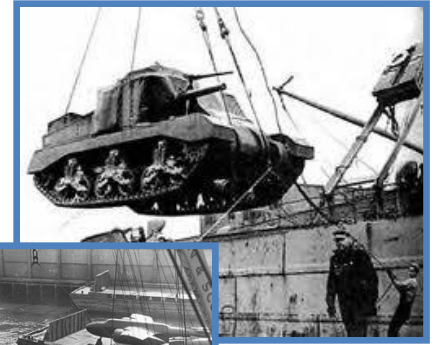
Battle of Britain.....

Section 2: The United States at War

Lend-Lease Act: The U.S. lends war supplies to Britain.

Now, the U.S. is involved in the war.



Atlantic charter: *FDR and Churchill meet secretly to discuss the world and the war.*



December 7, 1941

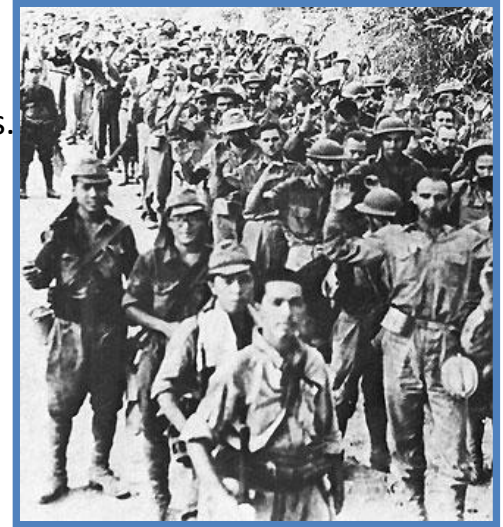
Pearl Harbor is attacked by the Japanese

Bataan Death March

- Japanese soldiers capture Allied soldiers in Philippines.
- Prisoners are forced to march 65 miles.
- Many are killed and many die from sickness.



Section 3: The War at Home

Rationing:



- Americans were asked to conserve food and other goods for the war effort.



Women and the War Effort

"Rosie the Riveter" = symbol of women's efforts during the war.



Japanese Internment

- U.S. government orders Japanese-Americans to be moved to camps to prevent sabotage and spying.
- Some of their rights are suspended.



Section 4: Toward Victory

Europe

Italy surrenders → Allies invade Europe (D-DAY) →
→ Allies invade Germany → Germany Surrenders.

The Pacific

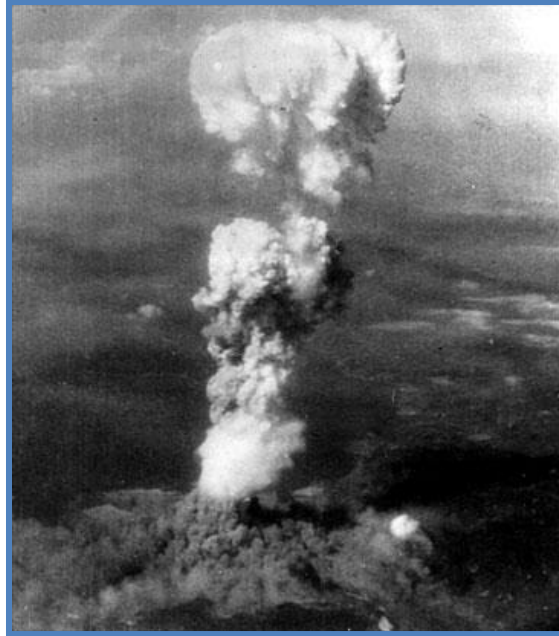
Island Hopping

- U.S. forces invade island in the Pacific Ocean as they approach Japan.

Japan refuses to surrender

The Atomic Bomb

- The U.S. uses the atomic bomb against Japan to force surrender
- Hiroshima & Nagasaki



The Holocaust

- Hitler and the Nazis attempt genocide against the Jewish people of Europe.
- Imprisonment of people in concentration camps.



Nuremberg Trials

- Nazi officials are charged with war crimes, found guilty, and executed.
