

- Expands the science research program to prepare students for national science competitions.
- Continues the 1:1 Chromebook initiative for all students at the Jr./Sr. High School.
- Includes extensive professional development for teachers.




- Continues the partnership with the DNA Learning Center.
- Provides new digital materials for student use at the Jr./Sr.
   High School, including online textbooks and resources.
- Funds arts programming, a partnership with the Huntington Arts Council, and the establishment of an Arts Honor Society.
- Appropriates a combined total of \$1,275,000 between the budget and Capital Reserve Fund to enhance the physical security of the schools and complete other infrastructure construction projects.

### **PROPOSITION TWO**

- To utilize \$575,000 from the Capital Reserve Fund (together with \$700,000 appropriated in the proposed budget) to complete \$1,275,000 of infrastructure construction projects <u>including \$240,000</u> in security upgrades.
- The capital reserve fund has a current balance of \$1,549,280.
