Popular shortcuts

- \* Take a screenshot: Press Ctrl + Show windows [Overview] (or Ctrl + F5).
- \* Take a partial screenshot: Press Shift + Ctrl + Show windows [Overview] (or Shift + Ctrl + F5), then click and drag.
- \* Take a screenshot (on tablets): Press Power button + Volume down button.
- \* Turn Caps Lock on or off: Press Search [Search] + Alt.
- \* Lock your screen: Press Search [Search] + L.
- \* Sign out of your Google Account: Press Shift + Ctrl + q (twice).
- \* See all keyboard shortcuts: Press Ctrl + Alt + / (forward slash).
